Youth MUST be enrolled in 4-H. If your child is not yet a 4-H member, they must be enrolled prior to registration of day camps. Enrollment requires a 4-H Enrollment form and a Florida 4-H Participation Form. You can get these forms online at <a href="http://jackson.ifas.ufl.edu">http://jackson.ifas.ufl.edu</a> or at the Jackson County Extension Office.

Whoever brings your child, and picks them up from, the day camp will need to sign them in and out each day.

Adult supervision will begin 10 minutes prior to the start of the day camp. Please do not bring your child before this time, and be sure to make arrangements to have your child picked up at the designated time each day.

Youth will be participating in indoor and outdoor activities. Youth should wear shorts, t-shirt and tennis shoes. NO FLIP FLOPS or SANDALS are allowed.

Snacks will be provided. Youth should bring their own lunch on designated days. Please make sure food allergies or dietary restrictions are updated on your child's 4-H Enrollment Form.

Youth will follow the 4-H Code of Conduct and exhibit positive character traits.

Youth and parents understand that if this contract is broken in any way, disciplinary actions (such as loss of privileges or removal from the class/camp, will result.
