Day Camp Information

Registration for all day camps begins April 15, at the Jackson County Extension Office. The deadline to register for each day camp will be July 2. Registration is on a first-come, first-serve basis, and fees must be paid in full at registration. Refunds will only be issued if requests are made before the registration deadline. When registering a child, parents/guardians will need to complete a 4-H Day Camp Form and a 4-H Enrollment Form. Required forms are available at the Jackson County Extension Office and at the county 4-H website at http://jackson.ifas.ufl.edu/4h/. Persons with disabilities should contact the Extension Office at least 10 working days prior to the event so that proper consideration can be given to the request. 4-H is the Youth Development Program of the Florida Cooperative Extension Service and the University of Florida's Institute of Food and Agricultural Sciences. 4-H programs are available to all youth between the ages of 5-18 regardless of gender, race, creed, color, religion, or disability.
