PRICING

Since it is impossible to evaluate the condition of a horse's mouth over the phone, we have established some basic guidelines for pricing. All prices are subject to change.

Examination / Evaluation of a mouth – No Charge (Farm Call Applicable)

We are happy to look through a group of horses in order to put them in a sort of "rank order" of which ones needs to be done the soonest, and which ones can wait a few months, etc. There is no charge for this service.

Young Horse Dentistry (1-4 years old) \$75 - \$150. This includes checking for retained caps, cap extraction, wolf tooth removal, minor floating.

Performance Dentistry - \$100 – 200. This includes a full dental examination, floating and bit seats for riding/ performance horses. Fees depend on the condition of the mouth.

Geriatric Dentistry - \$100 - \$200. This includes rebalancing mouths, incisor reductions, minor extractions, etc. Major extractions and advanced molar work may be additional.

Farm Call - \$50 - \$100. \$25 Local, \$50 North Florida, \$100 out of territory. Fee to be split among boarders.

Sedation - \$25 - \$50. Occasionally horses are done without sedation. Typically sedation is used for the comfort of the patient and the safety of the veterinarian and handler. Charges depend on the dose given and repeat sedation.

Discounts may be given for youth groups, riding clubs, pony club, 4-H and large groups of horses.

***Payment is due upon completion of services - the day the work is performed. ***

As a rule, Tune Ups does not "bill" clients unless previous arrangements have been made.
Cash, check or credit card payment is appreciated at the time of service.
