## FOOD RECOVERY PROGRAM

The Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (FDACS) is offering food recovery assistance, in the State of Florida, via The Food Recovery Program. This program is a coordinated effort with Florida farmers, civic organizations and other food relief agencies to identify and receive unmarketable food and distribute it to those in need. The primary goal is to reduce food waste, through field gleaning (i.e. gathering leftover crops from fields after they have been commercially harvested) while increasing farmer profit margins through tax incentives. Trained volunteers are available for field gleaning, post-harvest produce pick-up, as well as produce transportation. FDACS will ensure that donors are provided with the proper documentation for a potential **tax deduction** based on the number of pounds donated.
