Item # 1. Social media as a tool for disseminating information

- Surprised social media was ranked top because most county programs fear it must be more wanting of materials through social media
- Some folks may have operation issues (not know how to use it)



- Could include a social media session during future BEACONS workshop
- The AMCA has a Public Relations Committee. We will look for sessions on this topic at the annual meeting in Jacksonville.
- Beacons can help with material production and / or suggestions. Monthly posts? By season? Continuity of posts is important. Social media sites need to be active.
 Information is lost constantly and moves a lot.
 - Must ensure posts are regionally relevant.
- The group discussed a very successful social media campaign led by Dr. Ryan Carney (Wanted Posters for invasive species)
 - iNaturalist to for citizen scientist, fun and exciting way to engage the public
- The BEACONS website will feature news stories, UF/IFAS Blog posts. A banner that switches out information, we are currently building a repository.
- National Invasive Species Awareness Week beginning Monday February 28th 2022. It runs 5 days beginning on the last Monday of February.
 - Prepare blog/social media posts to promote the week

Item # 2. Webinars and virtual training opportunities

- Beacons board members will meet with FDACS (Jessica and Marah) to discuss webinar opportunities
- We discussed the process of attaining a CEU certification. Information is posted below:
 - BEACONS Board to seek CEU accreditation for each participating state.
