Earth Day is celebrated this month so be sure to do something fun and environmentally friendly such as planting a garden, composting, or a fun recycling activity.



4-H Camp Timpoochee has been a 4-H tradition in Holmes County since the 1930's. We want all Holmes County youth that want to attend camp be able to afford to go. Therefore, we are asking our community members to help reduce this burden on our 4-H families by supporting the upcoming 4-H Sunday Spaghetti Supper on Sunday, April 12, 2015 from 11:30 A.M. until 2:00 P.M at the Holmes County Ag Center in Bonifay.



Individuals may stop by any time between 11:30 and 2:00 P.M. to support 4-H by eating spaghetti supper at the ag center for just \$7.00 per adult, \$5.00 per youth. Each meal will include a huge portion of spaghetti, salad, bread, dessert and a drink. Take out dinners will be available. No RSVP is required.

4-H Youth Responsibilities: 4-H youth that are planning to attend camp are asked to donate one box of spaghetti noodles and/or one can of tomato sauce. 4-Hers are also encouraged to assist with preparation, serving, and clean up in order to be eligible to share in the fundraising proceeds. Camp Timpoochee Open Enrollment!

4-H Camp Timpoochee summer camp (June 15-19) is fast approaching! This year's camp theme is "Once Upon A Camp" which will involve cool fairy tales, legends, and myths from popular storybooks.

Registration for camp spots is still open. We only have 6 slots left available for campers, CIT, and Counselors this year before a waiting list is created. Camp Timpoochee fees will be \$250.00 again this year. CITs and Camp Counselors will received a discounted rate for their work at camp.

If your child plans to attend 4-H Camp Timpoochee, parent(s) must turn in a \$50.00 non-refundable deposit and a camp registration packet for each child to the 4-H Office! Slots cannot be saved for youth based on phone calls.

We have set up a payment option to help alleviate any burden due to the cost of camp, after the deposit and paperwork has been received. Remember to visit Tri-County Community Council in Bonifay as they may be able to provide scholarships for 4-H youth to attend camp.

Camp Scholarship Opportunity

Thanks to a very generous donor, Holmes County 4-H is able to offer one full camp scholarship (\$250.00) to a Holmes County youth, age 8-12. In order to apply for this camp scholarship, youth must write a one page essay on one of the following topics: Why 4-H is Important to Me OR Why I Love Going to 4-H Camp Timpoochee

The essay must be typed and submitted to Ms. Niki at ncraw-son@ufl.edu by May 1, 2015 in order to qualify to be selected. Youth must include their name, birthdate, age, phone number, and mailing address on the essay. A panel of judges will review all entries and select one essay winner to receive the full camp scholarship.

Prior to the end of camp, the scholarship winner must write a thank you note to the donor. Ms. Niki will assist the camper in the writing and mailing of the thank you note.

Congrats State Archery Match Team!



On Saturday, March 14, 2015, fourteen members of the Holmes County 4-H Dead Centers Archery Club accompanied by twenty-seven adults, traveled to Newberry, Florida to compete in the 2015 Florida 4-H State Archery Match. These youth worked hard to demonstrate their knowledge and abilities in the sport of archery due to the great instruction since September of 2014 from 4-H certified volunteers, Jim Forman and Ralph Bowdish.

This year, the Junior and Intermediate age groups were required to shoot 5-color face FITA targets with a total of 72 arrows at various distances appropriate for their age division. Of the fourteen members traveling to the competition, nine 4-Hers represented the Junior age category of 8-10: Layla Hodges, Roland Jackson, Noah Owens, Carson Sherrouse, Kaiya Owens and Isaac Boatwright (Instinctive Compound) and Chad Albury, Wes Cook and Racheal McCormick (Sighted Compound). Five 4-Hers represented the Intermediate age category of 11-13: Jack Middlebrooks (Sighted Recurve), Logan Chitty, Tyler Dunn, Hannah Faircloth and Seth Smith (Sighted Compound). These 4-Hers rose to the challenge and represented the county well in the shooting sports competition in the 4-H program.

After a long day of competition, the results were very impressive for Holmes County youth! The results were as follows:



In the Junior Age Instinctive Compound Division, Noah Owens, 1st place; Carson Sherrouse, 5th place; Layla Hodges, 6th place; and Isaac Boatwright, 7th place.

In the Junior Age Sighted Compound Division, Chad Albury, 4th place; Wes Cook, 7th place; and Racheal McCormick, 10th place.

1st Place Junior Team Award - Instinctive Compound Bow went to Layla Hodges, Roland Jackson, Carson Sherrouse, and Noah Owens.

2nd Place Junior Team Award - Sighted Compound Bow went to **Chad Albury**, **Wes Cook**, and **Racheal McCormick**.

In the Intermediate Age Sighted Compound Division, Seth Smith, 2nd place.

In the Intermediate Age Sighted Recurve Division, Jack Middlebrooks, 4th place.

We are very proud of all of our 4-H youth that attended the 4-H State Archery Match this year. They all did a fantastic job of demonstrating what they have learned in the sport of archery. We are thrilled that Holmes County 4-H had the opportunity to participate in this event. We thank all of the volunteers, parents, grandparents, and community leaders for their support of our archery program!
