Worms in Dirt Snack



Let's gather our materials...

- Jello Chocolate Pudding Cups Oreo Cookies
- Clear plastic cups (8 oz. works great)
 Gummy Worms
 - Small ziplock bags

Napkins

Plastic spoons

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Step 1

- Give each youth 5-6 oreo cookies.
- Pull apart oreo cookies and remove the icing,
- Place oreo cookies in ziplock bag.
- Crush cookies into crumbs while in the ziplock bag.
- Set aside until Step 2.



Step 2

- Open jello and scoop ½ of the pudding into the clear cup.
- Sprinkle a layer of the crumbled oreos.
- Drop 2-3 gummy worms into the oreo/pudding mixture.
 - Be sure you can see some of the worm along the side of

the clear cup.



Step 3

- Add the remaining pudding on top of the
 - oreo/worm layer.
- Sprinkle one last layer of crumbled oreos.
- Add 1-2 worms on top.

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
