What is the loan program's purpose?

To provide active 4-H and FFA members with a loan program that will afford them the opportunity to establish and operate income-producing projects. This loan program will teach them independent financial responsibility and valuable skills on acquiring and handling financing.





How does the program work?

The Youth Agricultural Loan Program will provide financial resources for the following purchases:

- Marketable livestock for show/sale projects (examples: breeding animals, horses, etc.)
- Crop or aquatic production projects (examples: growing crops, aquatic production, hay equipment, etc.)

What are the loan conditions?

- · Active 4-H or FFA member
- · Loans for maximum of \$2,500
- Project must be a qualified 4-H or FFA project and income producing
- · No fees
- Co-signed by parents/guardian
- Purchase of Stock up to 2% of loan amount
- Loan term not to exceed 18 months
