

Dear Potential Chick Parent:

I know that your child has shared with you the incredible journey that he/she has taken over the past three weeks while participating in the Jackson County 4-H Embryology in the Classroom Project. This project is in an introduction into the 4-H Poultry Education Program in Jackson County, and we are offering your child the chance to take home one of the chicks that they have watched develop and helped to care for. In order to take a chick home, you must return this signed letter indicating your agreement to the following:

1. I will provide a safe place for the chick that provides protection from predators, rain, wind and the sun. \*\*This includes a brooding lamp or heat source until the chick is old enough to maintain it's own body temperature.
2. I will provide food that is age appropriate and fresh clean water daily for the chick
3. I will contact the 4-H office with any questions I have, and in the event that I cannot care for the chick, I will return it to the 4-H office.
