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HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS TIPS – DAY FIVE ASSIGNMENT

We are continuing to take small steps in preparation for the potential hurricane or out disaster that may strike. Please consider doing one thing **TODAY** that would better prepare you for the threat.

Today we are going to continue preparing our Disaster Information Tub in case of disaster. We are adding needed tools and other things to our **Disaster Kit** so you can “grab it and go”.

Today you are going to add things that we would consider an **Evacuation Kit**. These are the things you are going to do and add:

- Locate the Disaster Information Tub you purchased
- Add the following item to it:
 - A Battery-operated radio
 - At least a 2-week supply of medication (you might want to rotate this supply to keep it as “new” as possible)
 - Extra clothing, including sturdy shoes (a trip to a resale store will allow you to add items that won’t be missed by your family. Do remember children don’t stand still and not change; periodically change these saved items to accommodate for size changes.)
 - First aid kit
 - Blanket and pillows

- Books and toys
- Confirm that you finished securing all of your important papers that were assigned last week---if you didn't finish that job today.

This is your assignment for today. Assemble all of the above and put them in your Disaster Tub!!!! Whew, this was a busy day. I will lighten the load tomorrow.
