THE LLOYD RHODEN AGRICULTURAL SCHOLARSHIP

In 1985 the North Florida Fair Association established a scholarship in honor of Mr. Lloyd Rhoden, a former Fair Manager and retired County Extension Director. Two \$1,000.00 scholarships are presented annually to students majoring in agriculture at a Florida Institute of higher learning and can be continued up to 4 years in duration for the high school senior receiving the initial annual award.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

To be eligible for the scholarship, a nominee must be a graduating high school senior from a <u>FLORIDA</u> county that annually places a county agricultural exhibit in the North Florida Fair, who:

- 1. Has indicated through 4-H, FFA, or related activities a sincere interest and potential ability in the fields of agriculture.
- 2. Plans to enter an institution of higher learning in the state of **FLORIDA** to study some phase of agriculture.
- 3. Has achieved an acceptable senior placement test score and acceptable grade point average in high school and maintains acceptable academic standing at the institution(s) attended to continue receiving the stipend. The recipient must maintain continuous enrollment with not more than one semester or summer off between two consecutive terms:
- 4. Changing majors in an area outside of an agriculture related area during the scholarship period will terminate the conditions of the scholarship award and the funds will no longer be granted.

HOW ARE THE RECIPIENTS SELECTED?

Nominations for scholarships must be made by a County Extension Faculty Member or a Vocational Agriculture Instructor and submitted to the Selection Committee appointed by the President of the North Florida Fair Association. Nomination Forms should be mailed back to the North Florida Fair Association as soon as possible. Nominated students will be mailed an application, which must be returned with all required paperwork to the Scholarship Committee **postmarked no later than May 5th**. Recipients will be selected by July 1st of each year. The scholarships will be available at the beginning of the fall semester and be paid to the winner(s) after registration at the selected institution and upon request of the President of the Association.
